

MUSEUM PASS POLICY

- 1. To borrow a museum pass, a Library patron must have a valid Hampstead Public Library card and be a patron in good standing.
- 2. Museum passes which are disposable paper do not need to be returned to the Library.
- 3. Some passes must be picked up at the Library, no more than two business days in advance of the museum visit. Library staff, at their discretion may give out a pass earlier.
- 4. Pass reservations may be made up to two months in advance. If the pass has not been reserved, it may be taken out the day of the visit on a first come first served basis.
- 5. A Library patron may reserve and borrow a specific museum pass once during a single month. This rule may be waived if the patron contacts the Library on the day they wish to visit, and the pass has not been reserved for that day.
- 6. A Library patron may only borrow 1 pass per day.
- 7. To cancel a pass reservation, use the link in the confirmation email you received, or contact the library. Reservations may be cancelled anytime until the day of the reservation.
- 8. Museum passes may not be renewed.
