

## Non-Resident Card Holder

Non-residents fall into the following categories;

- 1. A person who resides out of town and does not pay taxes, go to school or work year round in Hampstead.
- 2. A person who resides out of town but pays taxes in Hampstead.
- 3. A person who resides out of town but works year round or attends school in Hampstead.
- 4. A person who rents a seasonal dwelling.

Non-resident free: card expires in one year.

- 1. A person who resides out of town but pays taxes in Hampstead.
- 2. A person who resides out of town but works or attends school in Hampstead.

Non-resident paid: card expires in one year.

1. There is a \$50 per year fee for non-residents who do not pay taxes, go to school or work in Hampstead.

Non-resident short term: card expires in 4 months.

2. There is a \$20 fee for non-residents who do not pay taxes, go to school or work year round in Hampstead but are in Hampstead for a short period of time. The card will be valid for a period of 4 months and have limited checkout privileges. Patrons with this card may have only two items checked out at a time.

Relatives using a resident's card (i.e. a family member visiting for vacation) must bring the residents card with them to the library when they wish to check materials out.
